This section allows the District Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action and vendors presentation of information from any potential or current contractor of the district. The fourth section is called Business Items. The business items section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motion and votes on an item-by-item basis. Fifth section called Consent Agenda. The Consent Agenda section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The sixth section called Management Reports allows the District Administrator to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action and vendors presentation of information from any potential or current contractor of the district. If any member of the audience would like to speak on one of the business items, they will need to register with the District Administrator prior to the presentation of that agenda item. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. During the Public Hearing portion of the agenda item, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion and vote. Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 873-7300 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. The seventh section is called **Supervisor Requests**. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the district's needs. The final section is called Audience Questions, Comments and Discussion Forum. This portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the district. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

#### **How Low Can They Go?**

We are in the middle of Florida's dry season and we are seeing signs of low water levels in some ponds. It's also the time of year when we have warm and cold days which confuse Mother Nature's growth patterns.

When the water levels fall below normal, that leaves exposed banks that reveal a surplus of untapped nutrients. This nutrient rich area can give new weeds a growth boost. In the dry season, your Spray Tech is doing preventive work, too.

Ponds left untreated have plants that will take advantage of drought conditions and differing temperatures to encroach onto exposed bank areas and take root. When the water levels return to normal, two things will happen:

- 1 -Some of these plants will keep growing and be hard to get under control.
- 2 -Some drown and die which causes them to release all the nutrients they were holding. This will create a bright green algae ring around the shoreline.

In order to prevent future weed growth, we are treat the exposed banks now so when the water levels return the weeds will not be there to grow again. Exposed grasses like Slender Spikerush, Torpedo Grass and Eelgrass are hard to kill when water levels are normal. This is the best time to get to treat those and other unwanted vegetation that cause trouble at normal water levels.

Fish also feel the effect of a drought. The water can get too low and reduce their living space and oxygen levels. This puts stress on fish that may cause them to float near the top of the water. You may lose a few or the entire pond during the winter dry months.

There is no way to know how dry this year will be, but you can count on AWC to be there to keep your pond(s) under control now and in the future..









#### **Frigid Facts**



When you combine the cold temperatures with high winds the plants really feel it. Water and plant surface temperatures drop fast. Customers who have planted beneficial plants to help reduce nutrients leaching into ponds or for their landscape appeal are seeing brown plants. They may look dead but they are not. The roots under the water are healthy and ready for warm weather.



In the spring they will come back and do the job they were planted to do.

New annuals are scheduled to be planted this week.




The dead palm trees have been replaced at the clubhouse.

The turf along still Creek is in good condition.




Weed detailing has improved at the entrance beds.



# **Understanding Your Electric Charges**

**Average kWh per day** – The average amount of electricity purchased per day.

**Basic Service Charge** – A fixed daily amount that covers the cost to provide service to your location. This charge is billed monthly regardless of any electricity used.

**Bright Choices™**—The associated fees and charges for leased outdoor lighting services.

**Budget Billing** – Optional plan averages your home's last 12 monthly billing periods so you pay the same amount for your service each month.

Clean Energy Transition Mechanism (CETM) – A charge to recover costs associated with electric meter upgrades and the closing of certain coal generating plants to support Tampa Electric's transition to produce clean energy.

Energy Charge – For residential, small commercial and lighting customers, includes the cost (except fuel) of producing and delivering the electricity you purchased, including conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges. For other customers, the three cost recovery charges appear as separate line items.

**Estimated** – If Tampa Electric was unable to read your meter, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your meter will be read next month, and any difference will be adjusted accordingly.

**Florida Gross Receipts Tax** – A tax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. Utility companies collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax – A tax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting tangible personal property at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Florida Statutes.

**Franchise Fee** – A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property to provide electric service. The fee is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

**Fuel Charge** – Cost of fuel used to produce electricity you purchased. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric.

For more information about your bill, please visit tampaelectric.com.

**Kilowatt-Hours (kWh)** – The basic measurement of electric energy use.

Late Payment Charge – For past due amounts more than \$10, the late payment charge is the greater of \$5 or 1.5% of the past due amount. For past due amounts of \$10 or less, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

**Municipal Public Service Tax** – Many municipalities levy a tax on the electricity you use. It is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

**Past Due** – Previous charges that are past due are subject to a late payment charge fee and may result in disconnection.

Rate Schedule – The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

**Share** – A Tampa Electric program administered by the Salvation Army and the Catholic Charities Diocese of St. Petersburg that helps pay energy bills of customers in need. If you choose to contribute, your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Tampa Electric.

**Storm Protection Charge** – The cost of additional hardening efforts to further protect the power grid from hurricanes or other extreme weather events.

**Sun Select™** – The cost of producing energy you purchased from dedicated solar generation facilities. You pay no fuel charge for the Sun Select portion of your bill.

Sun to Go™ – The amount of electricity purchased from solar generating sources serving the Sun to Go program, which provides optional renewable energy purchases in 200 kWh blocks.

**Total Amount Due** – This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It's important that you pay your bill before this date to avoid interruption of service.

**Zap Cap Systems**\* – Surge protection for your home or business sold separately as a non-energy charge.




