Terms & Conditions of Special Services Agreement

- If CUSTOMER requires ASI to enroll in any special third-party compliance programs invoicing or payment plans that charge ASI, those charges will be invoiced back to CUSTOMER.
- 2. CUSTOMER agrees that the services to be provided are for the benefit of CUSTOMER regardless of whether the CUSTOMER has direct legal ownership of the water areas specified. In the event that CUSTOMER does not directly own the areas where services are to be provided, CUSTOMER warrants and represents that he has control of these areas to the extent that he may authorize the specified services and agrees to defend, indemnify and hold ASI harmless for the consequences of such services not arising out of ASI sole negligence.
- 3. Neither party shall be responsible in damages, penalties or otherwise for any failure or delay in the performance of any of its obligations hereunder caused by strikes, riots, war, acts of God, accidents, governmental order and regulations, curtailment or failure to obtain sufficient material or other cause (whether or not of the same class or kind as those set forth above) beyond its reasonable control and which, by the exercise of due diligence, it is unable to overcome. Should Aquatic System's, Inc. be prohibited, restricted or otherwise prevented from rendering specified services by any of the conditions, Aquatic Systems, Inc. shall notify CUSTOMER of said condition and of the excess direct costs arising therefrom. CUSTOMER shall have thirty (30) days after receipt of said notice to terminate this Agreement by so notifying Aquatic Systems, Inc. in writing.

- 4. **ASI**, at its expense, shall maintain the following insurance coverage: Workman's Compensation (statutory limits), General Liability, Property Damage, Products and Completed Operations Liability, and Automobile Liability.
- 5. ASI, agrees to hold CUSTOMER harmless from any loss, damage or claims arising out of the sole negligence of Aquatic Systems. Inc.; however, ASI, shall in no event be liable to CUSTOMER, or others, for indirect, special or consequential damages resulting from any cause whatsoever.
- 6. Collection terms are net 30 days from invoice date. In consideration of **ASI'S** providing services and/or products, the CUSTOMER agrees to pay its invoice/statement within 30 days of the invoice/statement date. All amounts remaining due and owing 30 days after billing by SELLER shall bear interest at the rate of 1.5% per month until paid in full. The CUSTOMER shall pay all costs of collection, including liens and reasonable attorney's fees. ASI may cancel this Agreement, if CUSTOMER is delinquent more than sixty (60) days on their account. *Checks should be payable to Aquatic Systems, Inc.*
- 7. It is the CUSTOMER'S responsibility to inform ASI of any and all work areas that are required mitigation sites in which desirable plants have been or are to be installed. CUSTOMER agrees to provide ASI with copies of mitigation permits, site plans, plant species, etc. relating to contracted work areas. ASI assumes no responsibility for damage to desirable plants where CUSTOMER has failed to disclose such information to ASI.
- 8. Cyanobacteria identification and toxin testing are not included in this agreement. Cyanobacteria are common throughout Florida waterways and our algae management program cannot guarantee the absence, elimination or control of cyanobacteria and toxins. ASI shall in no event be liable to CUSTOMER, or others, for indirect, special or consequential damages resulting from the presence of cyanobacteria or cyanobacteria toxins in their waterbodies.
- 9. Water use restrictions after treatment are not often required. When restrictions are required, **ASI** will post signs and notify CUSTOMER. It is the CUSTOMER'S responsibility to maintain the posted signs throughout the required period. **ASI** does not assume any liability for failure by any party to be notified of, or to observe, the above regulations.
- 10. Carp Containment Barrier(s): ASI is <u>not</u> responsible under any circumstances for flooding or water damage from fouled water level control structures resulting from ASI installing Carp Containment Barriers on the structures.
- 11. This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement of the parties hereto and no oral or written alterations or modifications of the terms contained herein shall be valid unless made in writing and accepted by an authorized representative of both ASI and the CUSTOMER.
- 12. In the event legal action is instituted to enforce this Agreement or any portion hereof, the prevailing party shall be entitled to an award of reasonable attorney's fees, in addition to court and other costs, including, but without limitation, fees and costs in conjunction with any proceeding before any appellate tribunal.

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors for Parkway Center Community Development District was held on **Wednesday**, **January 24**, **2018 at 6:30 p.m.** at the Rivercrest CDD Clubhouse at 11560 Ramble Creek Drive, Riverview, FL 33569.

1. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

Nicole Chamberlain called the Regular Meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the Parkway Center Community Development District to order on Wednesday, January 24, 2018 at 6:37 p.m.

2. AUDIENCE QUESTIONS AND COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

There were no audience questions or comments on agenda items.

3. VENDOR/STAFF REPORTS

A. District Counsel

Discussion on Taylor Morrison's request for rezoning modification. Scott Steady cautioned the district from getting involved in what stance the community takes. Supervisor Fleary said he doesn't want the CDD to get involved, but he does think that Taylor Morrison could have come to the meeting or at least let Mr. Steady know what their plans are. Mr. Steady said he isn't defending them. Supervisor Fleary asked Supervisor Ward to confirm that when the representative from Taylor Morrison came to the meeting he said they had no plans to build in the Eagle Preserve. Supervisor Ward said that she believes what he said was that at that time Taylor Morrison had no intention to build in that area. More discussion followed and the group was in agreement that Taylor Morrison strategized not to come until after the rezoning hearing.

Mr. Steady talked about the parcel of land for sale. He said he knows the owner and the property is still available. Mr. Steady said even if the Board decides to buy the property that they need another meeting before they really move forward. He suggested having a workshop in a couple of weeks. Tonja Stewart said the Board received the draft report. An environmental specialist will go onsite and look at the property. Things are moving in a positive direction. They can't test for sink holes because of all the trees that are onsite. Mr. Steady said that it looks like most of the acreage can be developed and used for what the community wants. Supervisor O'Connor said that in addition to testing for sink holes Brian Howell had mentioned checking for dumping. Mr. Steady said they need to have someone walk the site to see if dumping is an issue. Mr. Steady said they could have a Phase 1 audit done for \$2,500. Mr. Steady said he thinks the audit should be done sooner rather than later. The Board was pretty sure that they had already agreed to move forward with the audit. Mr. Steady explained the 2004 and 2008 bonds and the differences. He also explained the benefit of refinancing the 2004A bonds and that it would generate \$800,000 (+) in available funds. He also discussed the increase to homeowners with levying the amended assessments. If the Board goes through with the financing and agree then should move forward with the Phase 1 audit. Supervisor Fleary asked if they can have the steps laid out for them regarding what needs to be done. Supervisor Ward asked if based on the size of the community there is a guideline for how big the clubhouse and parking lot should be. Mr. Steady said the critical information is how much of the land can be developed. Property values will go up if they move forward. It does need to be determined what the increase to the operations and maintenance will be. Mr. Steady discussed the additional action items and processes that need to be completed. They need to file a complaint and sue the state of Florida to validate the bonds. The next step is Mr. Steady contacting county to obtain an agreement and more due diligence needs to be done. Mr. Steady said a geotechnical review also needs to be done. There was a question on the approved amount Ms. Stewart has to spend. The Board was fairly sure that the amount was \$10,000 and Meritus also has spending authority. Nicole Chamberlain is to check meeting minutes. The Board discussed the idea of a workshop. They would like a date in between the February and March meetings. They also discussed putting up signs within the community to let them know about the workshop.

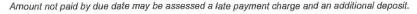

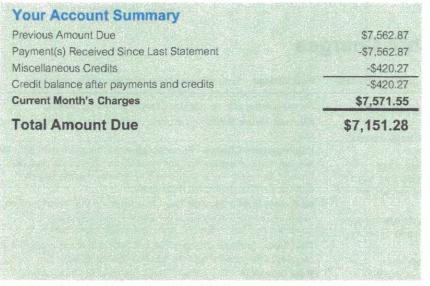

Understanding Your Electric Charges

Average kWh per day – The average amount of electricity purchased per day.

Basic Service Charge - A fixed monthly amount to cover the cost of providing service to your location.

Bright Choices_{BM} - The number of light fixtures and/or poles leased from Tampa Electric, and associated fees and charges.

Budget Billing—Optional plan takes the highs and lows out of monthly electric bills. This "leveling" billing plan averages your last 12 monthly billing periods so you can pay about the same amount for your service each month.

Energy Charge – The cost (except fuel) of producing the electricity you purchased, including conservation, environmental and capacity cost recovery charges.

Estimated – If Tampa Electric was unable to read your meter, "ESTIMATED" will appear. Your electric use has been estimated based on previous usage. The meter is scheduled to be read next month, and any difference between the estimate and actual use will be adjusted accordingly.

Florida Gross Receipts Tax – A tax is imposed on gross receipts from utility services that are delivered to retail customers in Florida, in accordance with Chapter 203 of the Florida Statutes. The tax is levied on utility companies, which collect the tax from all customers, unless exempt, and remit to the state.

Florida State Tax – A privilege tax imposed on every person who engages in the business of selling or renting tangible personal property at retail in the state, in accordance with Chapter 212 of the Florida Statutes.

Franchise Fee – A fee levied by a municipality for the right to utilize public property for the purpose of providing electric service. Like taxes, the fee is collected by Tampa Electric and is paid to the municipality.

Fuel Charge – Cost of fuel used to produce electricity you purchased. Fuel costs are passed through from fuel suppliers to our customers with no markup or profit to Tampa Electric.

Kilowatt-Hours (kWh) – The basic measurement of electric energy use

Late Payment Charge – For past due amounts more than \$10, the late payment charge is the greater of \$5 or 1.5% of the past due amount. For past due amounts of \$10 or less, the late payment charge is 1.5% of the past due amount.

Municipal Public Service Tax – In addition to the Franchise Fee, many municipalities levy a tax on the electricity you use. It is collected by Tampa Electric and paid to the municipality.

Past Due – Previous charges that are past due are subject to a late payment charge fee and may result in disconnection.

Rate Schedule – The amount (rate) you pay depends on your customer category. The cost of providing service varies with the customer group.

Renewable Energysa – The amount of electricity purchased from renewable sources.

Share – A program co-sponsored by Tampa Electric and the Salvation Army where customers can help pay the energy bills of customers in need. A one-time contribution can be made, or your monthly elected contribution will appear on your bill. Your contribution is tax deductible and is matched by Tampa Electric.

Total Amount Due – This month's charges will be past due after the date shown. THIS DATE DOES NOT EXTEND THE DATE ON ANY PREVIOUS BALANCE. It is important that you pay your bill before this date in order to avoid interruption of service.

Management Summary

Overall, the ponds within the Parkway Center CDD looked good during today's inspection. Positive results were observed within Ponds #5 and #10 following last months Algaecide applications, effectively reducing Algal coverage by approximately 85%. Additionally, native vegetation was observed surfacing along the shorelines, displaying healthy green leaves. Native plant species will continue to be promoted during our routine maintenance visits to improve the functionality of storm water retention Ponds (improved nutrient and pollution uptake, soil stability, and improved water clarity). It is recommended to plant the perimeter and shelves of ponds experiencing recurring blooms to reduce undesirable growth and improve pond aesthetics. The following 10 ponds were visually assessed during today's inspection: Ponds #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #9, #10, #11, #16, and #17 respectively.

The shorelines of the Parkway Center CDD continue to look good following our routine maintenance visits. Only minor development of Torpedograss and Pennywort were present within Pond #3, and several new sprouts of Cattails within Ponds #1 and #11, all of which will be treated during our scheduled maintenance visits. Positive results may be expected within 14-21 days following herbicide applications. Note: spot-treatments are performed in the vicinity of desirable plant species to reduce the amount of collateral damage.

Only Pond #9 was identified with minor floating Duckweed, which will be targeted during our scheduled maintenance visits. Similarly to Algae, Duckweed may develop rapidly within stagnant, nutrient rich water-bodies. Positive results may be expected within 14-21 days following treatment.

Lastly, minor submersed Filamentous Algae was present within Pond #1, and moderate to substantial growth of Planktonic Algae within Pond #16, both of which will be targeted during our upcoming scheduled visits. Algae is expected to clear within 10-14 days following Algaecide application. The new growth of Algae is likely a result of an influx of nutrients in the form of storm water runoff. As water travels through roadways and lawns, pollutants and nutrients are collected and deposited within nearby storm water retention ponds. Best management practices, such as proper disposal of yard waste and appropriate use of fertilizers are recommended to reduce the amount of nutrients entering our waterways.

Recommendations/Action Items

- Routine Maintenance.
- Continue to monitor all ponds for Algal growth and target on contact.
- Target Algae within Ponds #1 and #16.
- Treat minor shoreline weeds within Ponds #1, #3, and #11.
- Monitor Cattail treatment within Pond #8 and re-treat as necessary.
- Continue to promote native vegetation throughout the community.
- Target minor Duckweed within Pond #9.
