Mr. Steady went over the current status of the amenity project and pending bond issuance. The bond validation hearing is set for Monday, November 5, 2018, and the bonds likely will be issued in early December. Jon Kessler with FMS Bonds went over the refinancing of the 2004 bonds along with the issuance of the new bonds. He stated that the refinance would be for a max of \$5 million, and the new bonds would be \$4.740 million. Mr. Kessler anticipated that the interest rate would be 4.5 % but would not exceed the original percentage forecasted in the assessment methodology report of 5.05%. If this holds true, then the assessment increase will be less to the residents than originally predicted. The B bonds will be paid off by next month, and the assessment increase will not hit residents until the 2019 tax bill next fall.
