He also mentioned that there are some larger alligators in some of the ponds. Mr. Howell explained that FWC can be called if the alligators are large and being aggressive. Supervisor Miller also mentioned that drag racing is going on and that an RV is parking on the road. Mr. Howell said they could call the Sheriffs. The Board and Mr. Howell thanked and recognized Supervisor Fleary for his service on the CDD Board.
