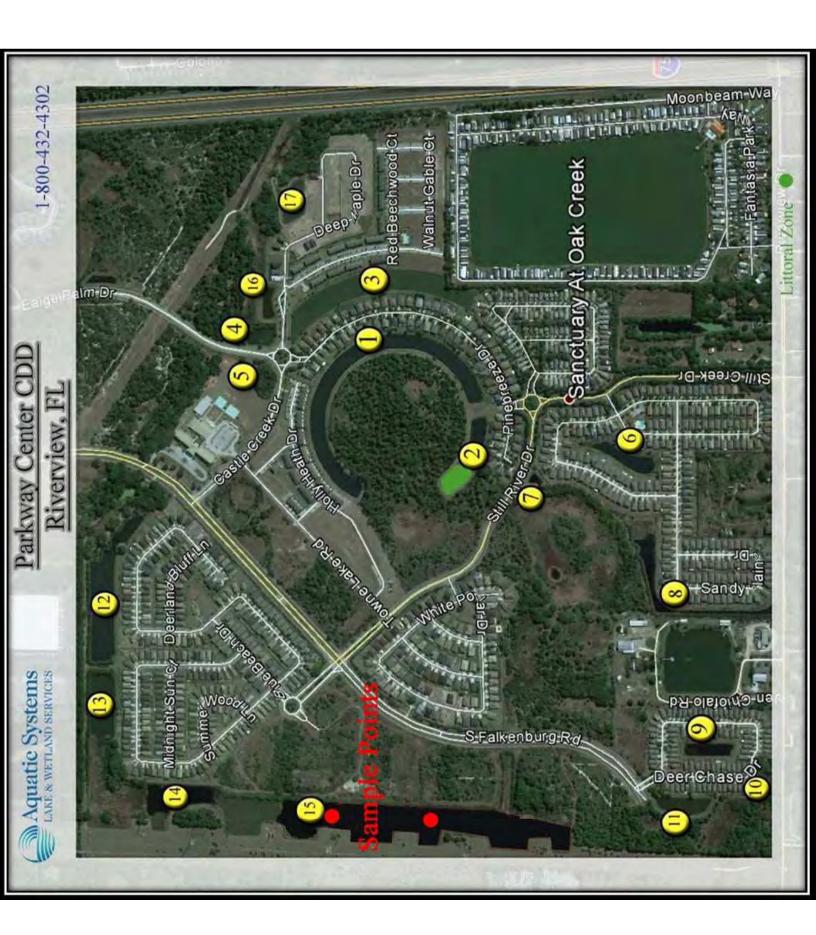

Dear Brian:

Our detailed survey of Site #8 at Parkway Center CDD indicates the need for beneficial wetland plant introduction.

Native aquatic plants are vital components of lake, pond and canal ecosystems. They form an important link between the base of the foodweb and the higher forms of plant and animal life. These plants provide protection, spawning and feeding habitats for aquatic animals, waterfowl and fish. Water quality is directly improved by the balance of ecological factors, including the presence of native wetland plants.

We recommend introduction of clusters of the emergent aquatic plant species as per the attached quotation(s).

These selected areas along the littoral region are indicated on the attached map.

Environmental benefits of a planting will be:

Creation of wildlife sanctuary and waterfowl nesting areas.

Sediment filtration.

Absorption of excessive nutrients (from fertilization and road runoff).

Erosion deterrent.

Increased food chain supply.

Improved fish habitat.

Enhanced aesthetics (shoreline is presently barren).

A total one-time investment includes all wetland plant material, labor, insurance and travel time necessary for completion of your planting.

Management Summary

Overall, the Ponds within Parkway Center CDD continue to look good following our routine maintenance. The following 10 ponds were visually assessed during today's inspection: Ponds #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #9, #10, #11 and #15 respectively.

As the summer months approach, the water temperatures within the ponds will begin to increase. This increase in temperatures will promote the growth of aquatic plants, including Algae. Despite the warmer temperatures that favor Algal growth, most of the ponds within the community were clear of Algae during today's inspection. All ponds within the community will continue to be monitored and treated if necessary. Normal Algal growth was present on Ponds #4 and #9. The minor Filamentous Algae on Ponds #4 and #9 will be targeted during our upcoming routine visits. Positive results should be seen within 10-14 days following treatment.

Invasive shoreline weeds, such as Torpedograss, Alligatorweed and Pennywort, were observed along the perimeter of Ponds #1, #3, #4, #5, #9 and #11. The minor grasses on each pond will be treated during our routine visits. Positive results should be seen within 21-28 days following treatment.

Duckweed is a free-floating weed that can form dense colonies along the surface of a slow or still moving waterbody. The minor floating weed was observed along the perimeter of Pond #9, which will be targeted during our routine visits. Positive results should be seen within 14-21 days following treatment.

Pond #15 was observed to have a moderate coverage of Water Lettuce and Water Hyacinth during today's inspection, both of which were treated during our routine visit on 3/22. Due to the reoccurring issues within the pond, a lake assessment is highly recommended. A lake assessment will show what the underlying cause of the issues such as nutrient overload or stratification.

Recommendations/Action Items

- Routine Maintenance.
- Continue to monitor all ponds for Algal growth and target on contact.
- Target the minor Filamentous Algae on Ponds #4 and #9.
- Continue to treat all sites for invasive vegetation during our routine visits.
- Treat the minor grasses on Ponds #1, #3, #4, #5, #9 and #11.
- Target the floating Duckweed in Pond #9.
- Monitor the results following treatment of Water Lettuce and Water Hyacinth on Pond #15.
