The sixth section called Management Reports allows the District Administrator to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action and vendors presentation of information from any potential or current contractor of the District. If any member of the audience would like to speak on one of the business items, they will need to register with the District Administrator prior to the presentation of that agenda item. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. During the Public Hearing portion of the agenda item, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion and vote. Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 397-5120 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. The seventh section is called Supervisor Requests. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet the District's needs. The final section is called Audience Questions, Comments and Discussion Forum. This portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

Action Item Description: Capture in a sentence or two the task or the item requiring additional research.

This must be clear enough that the context is understood and people will remember what exactly they were supposed to do. Phrase it as a task, not a

question.

Responsible: Identify the person that will "own" the action item.

Open Date: Date action item was created in a meeting.

Date Due: Date the "owner" and project team agrees the action item must be resolved.

Closed Date: Date action item was resolved to the satisfaction of the "owner' and the team.

Status: O= Open (actively being worked) or

C= Closed (item resolved). Once items are classified as "C" or closed, you can either gray out the line or move all the closed items to a second "Closed" tab.

Remember - do not change the Action Item number.

Comments: Used to track updates, additional questions, or names of additional resources that

should be consulted when working to resolve the action item. Also use this to log

the final resolution to the item.

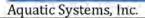

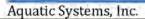

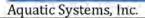

Management Summary

Overall, the ponds within Parkway Center CDD look great! The coverage of floating weed on Pond #15 has been reduced following our routine treatments! The following 10 ponds were visually assessed during today's inspection: Ponds #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, #6, #9, #10, #11 and #15 respectively.

Stormwater runoff is rainfall that flows over the ground surface. It is created when rain falls on roads, driveways, parking lots, rooftops, and other paved surfaces that do not allow water to soak into the ground. Stormwater runoff also picks up and carries with it many different pollutants that are found on paved surfaces such as sediment, Nitrogen, Phosphorus, bacteria, oil and grease, trash and pesticides. Due to the recent heavy rainstorms, the ponds within the community were observed to have higher water levels and minor debris. Despite the influx of stormwater runoff, Algal growth throughout the community was limited to only one pond! Minor Bottom to Surface Filamentous Algae was present within Pond #9, which will be treated during our routine visits. Positive results should be seen within 7-10 days following treatment.

Invasive shoreline weeds, such as Torpedograss, Alligatorweed and Pennywort, were observed on 7 out of the 10 ponds during today's inspection. Ponds #1, #2, #4, #5, #6, #9 and #11. The minor grasses on each of the ponds will be treated during our routine visits and positive results should be seen within 14-21 days following treatment. Terrestrial grasses, such as Primrose, Dog Fennel and Cattails were prevalent along the exposed banks and shorelines of Ponds #1, #2, #9 and #11. The terrestrial grasses on the exposed banks and along the shoreline on each of the ponds will be treated during our routine visits.

Floating weeds were prevalent along the perimeter and throughout Ponds #4, #9 and #15. The minor Watermeal on Pond #4; the minor Duckweed and Watermeal on Pond #9; and the moderate Water Lettuce and Water Hyacinth on Pond #15 will each be targeted during our upcoming routine visits. Positive results following treatments should be seen within 14-21 days.

Decaying grass clippings were observed along the perimeter of Pond #3, #4, #6, #9 and #11. Due to stormwater runoff picking up fresh grass clippings, there were minor patches decaying within the ponds. The water clarity within the ponds was also observed to be turbid due to the amount of rain the ponds have recently received.

Recommendations/Action Items

- Routine Maintenance.
- Continue to monitor all ponds for Algal growth and target on contact.
- Target the minor Bottom to Surface Filamentous Algae on Pond #9.
- Continue to treat all sites for invasive shoreline weeds.
- Treat the minor grasses on Ponds #1, #2, #4, #5, #6, #9 and #11 during our routine visits.
- Target the floating weeds on Ponds #4, #9 and #15.
